

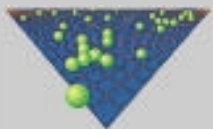

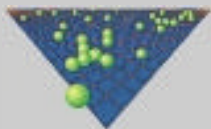

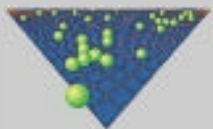

The new FIRST membership process

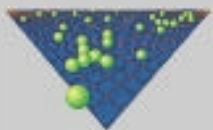
- **Membership committee started working on that January 2004**

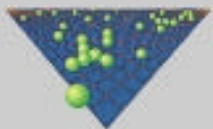
Differences between TI and FIRST (1)

<i>Application Phase</i>	TI	FIRST
Sponsors	./.	2
Time for the application to succeed	1+3 months	6 months
Site visit	no	mandatory
Minimum size of team	1 individual	2 individuals



Differences between TI and FIRST (2)

<i>Maintenance Phase</i>	TI	FIRST
number of updates per year	3	2
disclosure of team members	no (optional)	yes (mandatory)
