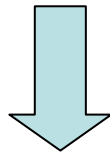

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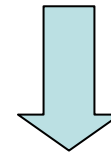
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Introduction and Context

Many users have experienced serious errors and faults with their equipment or software.



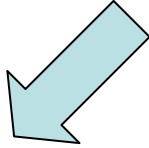
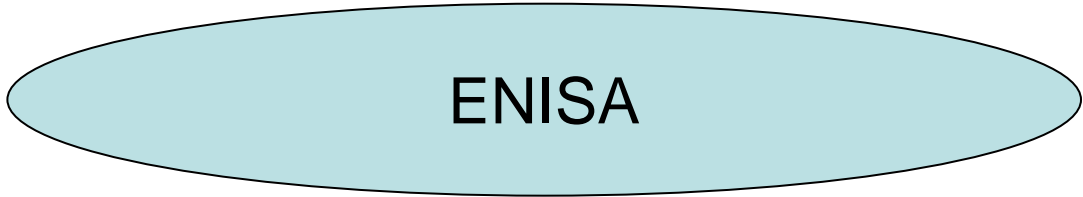
Internet security is a prime reason given by users for not trusting the Internet for payments.

Information security is a concern for everybody –

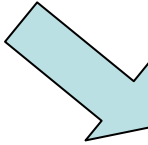
We need to achieve a culture of security.

The Creation of ENISA

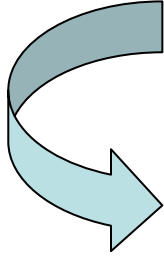
- Interconnection has increased the need to cooperate both across sectors and across national borders.
