 - IRT object developed in joint effort of RIPE NCC and volunteers from within RIPE and the TI



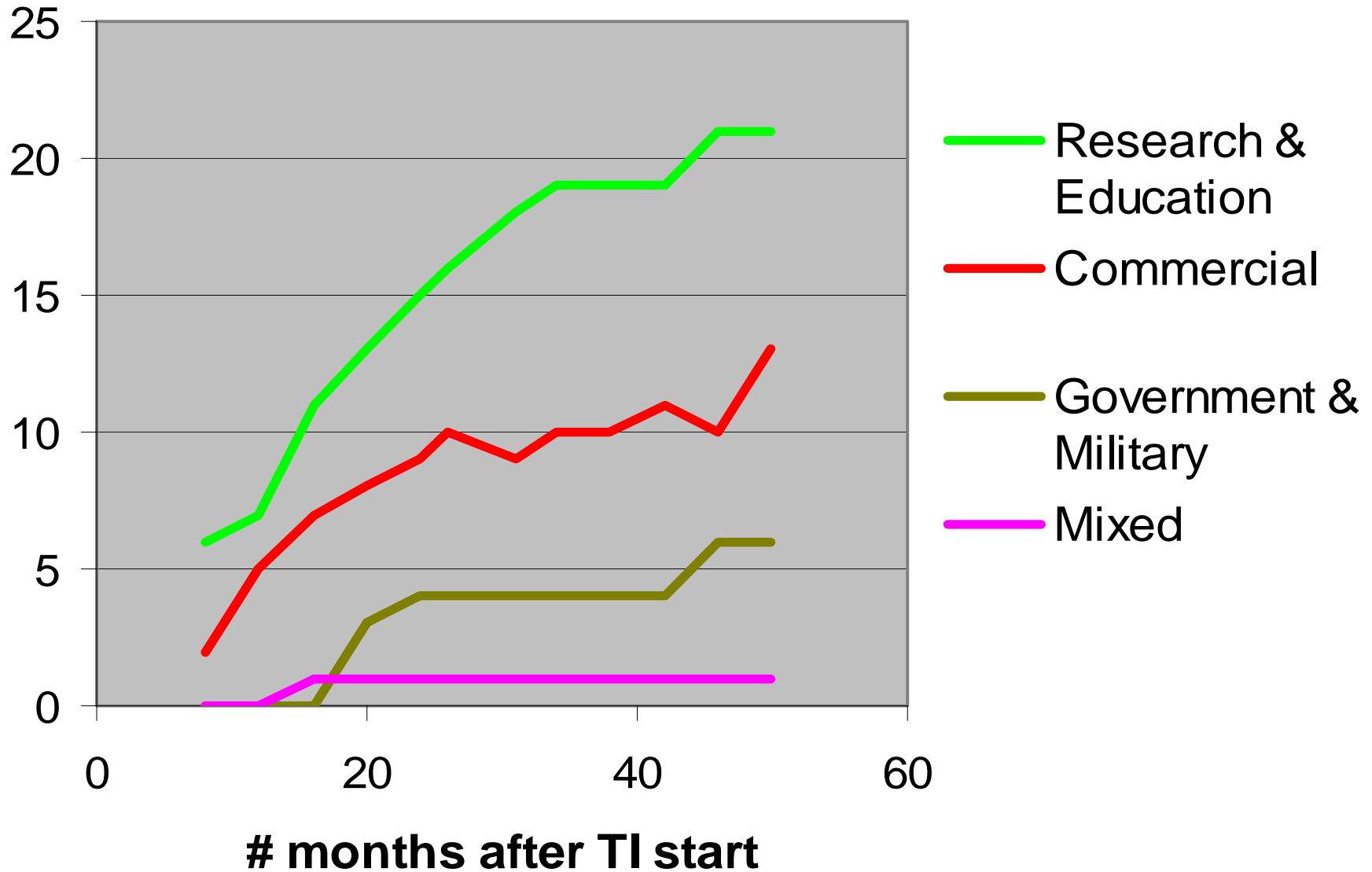
TI services for accredited teams only



- Restricted site for accredited teams
 - Move from uid/pwd → X509 certificates
- Extensive team information
- Formal key signing
- IRT object maintenance
- Downloadable contact lists, CSVs, keyrings etc.
- In-band alerting using crypto mail gateway
- Out-of-band alerting using voicemail and SMS
- Statistics gathering
- Under development: CSIRT Code of Practice
