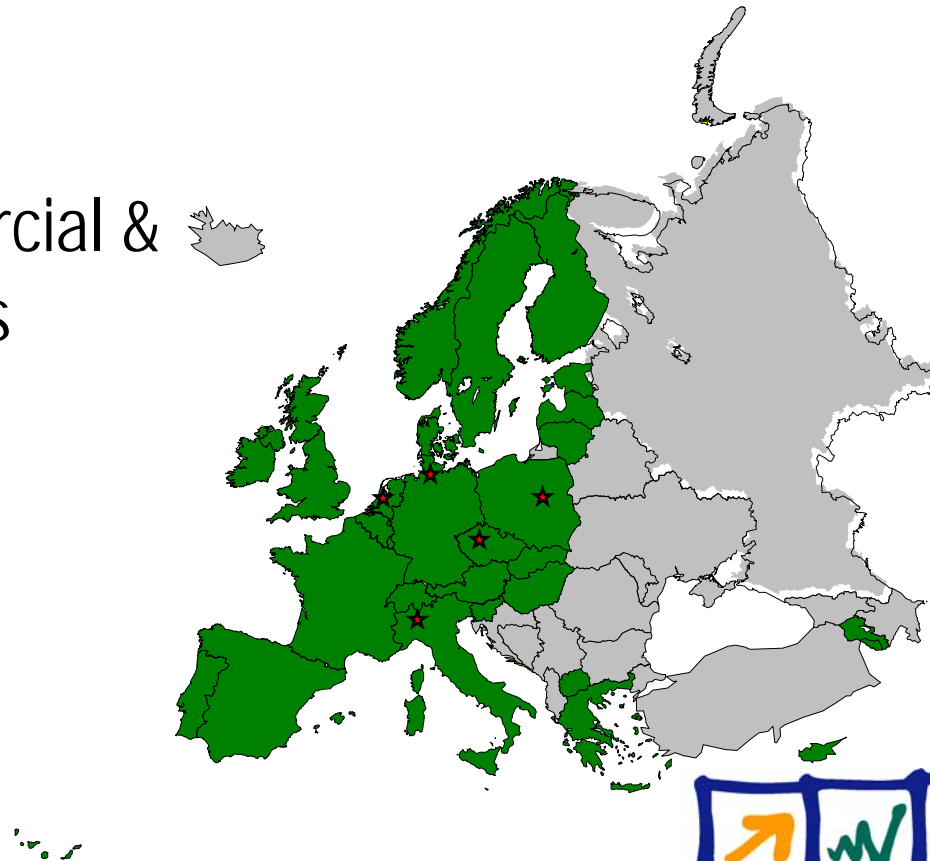

# Students by country (1)



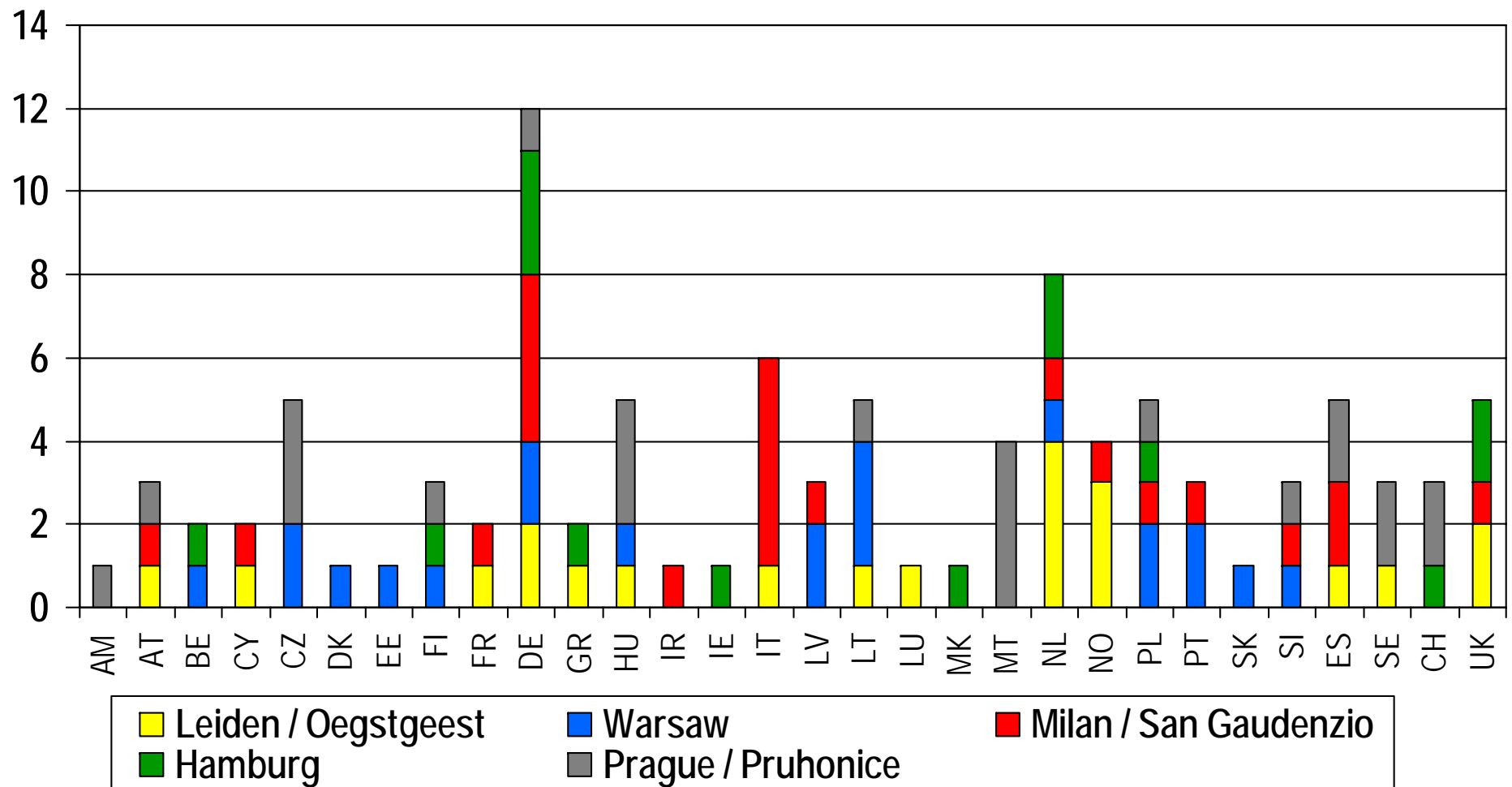
30 countries

Increase in commercial & government sectors

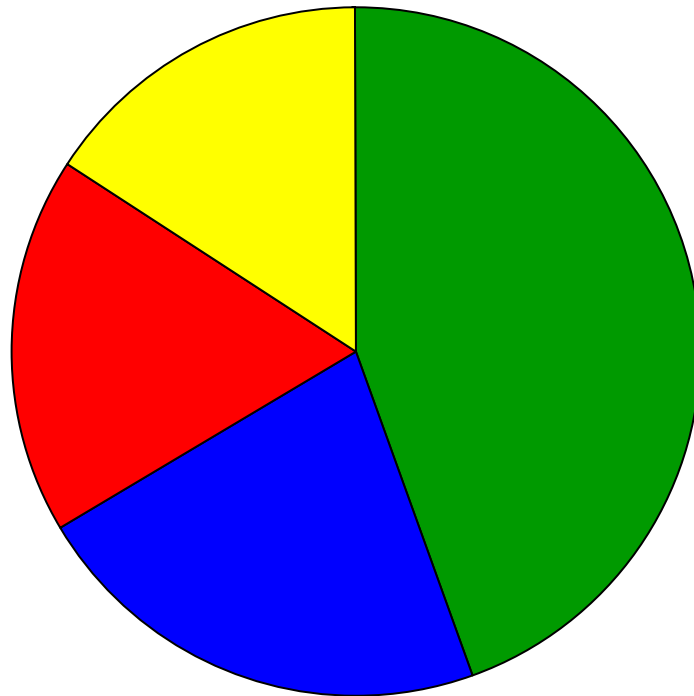

# There will be only two more TRANSITS training courses



The budget available in the TRANSITS project is sufficient to organise 7 training workshops (instead of 6 as planned originally).

There will be only two more TRANSITS training workshops:

- Chantilly (France), 17-18 February 2005  
Fully booked (much oversubscribed)
- end of April or end of May 2005



# Other world regions



Agreement between TRANSITS and FIRST (June 2004):

- FIRST can use TRANSITS materials for training courses in Latin America and Asia-Pacific
- Budapest, 18-19 June 2004 "Train the Trainers": twelve staff members of CSIRTs in Latin America and Asia-Pacific
- FIRST to organise two training courses in 2004 and three in 2005
- First training course organised by FIRST in Rio de Janeiro, 26-27 November 2004
  - Very successful, 22 participants from 12 countries



# After the end of the TRANSITS project



A possibility is that FIRST will take responsibility for updating the materials and for organising workshops in Europe (as well as in Latin America and Asia-Pacific)

- Meeting with FIRST executives on 8 February 2005
