- A tool for incident handling.

- TF-CSIRT WG trying create a powerful and easy to use IHS.
- Requirements
  - RT interaction
  - Multiple Constituency
  - Full GPG integration
  - New reporting tools
  - RTFM (RT FAQ Manager) integration
  - Cleaning and Incident Aging tool
  - Documentation

# What is going on

- Every WG's members signed the Code of Conduct.
- RTIR requirements (v1.3) have been finalised.
- Funding has been finalised and allocated
  - The amount for the project is \$95350.
- Statement of Work is almost complete, still discussing the last points.
  - Last meeting was focused on this point.
