- 30 individual members appointed till 2007
 - Representing industry, users, academia
- Advises Executive Director
 - Input into Agency Work Programmes
 - Agrees Working Group Terms of Reference
- Meetings in 2006
 - February 2006, Vienna
 - May 2006, Athens
 - June 2006, joint strategy workshop with MB, London
 - October 2006, Rome



Working Groups

- Members: up to 9 European experts per WG
 - CSIRT WG contains a lot of familiar names ☺
- 2005 (complete): results on website
 - CSIRTs (inventory, checklist for new teams)
 - Risk Management
 - Awareness Raising
- 2006 (proposed)
 - CSIRTs etc. (services, users, requirements, gaps)
 - To include abuse teams, WARPs, etc.
 - Leads to a clear 'to do' list for member states and others
 - Risk Management
 - Regulatory Issues
 - An inventory of EC legislation affecting NIS



Draft Work Programme 2007



- Process
 - Input from PSG in February and May
 - To be agreed by Management Board
- Main activities
 - Information gathering
 - Collaboration with member states, EC, other countries, industry, users
 - Communication and Outreach => implementation
- Areas of interest
 - Security tools, CSIRTs, awareness raising, risk management, authentication systems, quality measurement & assurance, new technologies (threats and opportunities), etc.
