ENISA

- European Network and Information Security Agency
 - NOT euro-CSIRT
 - NOT euro-NSA
- Advises Member States and Commission
 - How to develop a culture of security
 - NOT cybercrime and national security

What? Who?

- Agency, created in 2004 for five years
- 54 staff
 - Including Marco & Mehis, who send their apologies
- Management Board
 - Represents States, Commission, Consumers
 - Does management, financial and political stuff
 - Including Gorazd
- Permanent Stakeholders Group
 - 30 members, appointed as individuals
 - Advises on technical work programme, etc.
 - Including me

Work so far

- Awareness Raising
 - Guides for different communities
- Risk Assessment
 - Analysis of methods
- New Technologies
 - Authentication, Social Networks, Botnets,...
- CSIRTs
 - Inventory, guides, courses (TRANSITS), ...
 - End-user behaviour & needs, certification,...
- Commission requests
 - ISP security measures, legal instruments, information sharing...
- Etc.

Long-term future

- Current mandate ends in 2009
 - External review favourable, but
 - Says agency is too small
- So COM propose a larger Agency
 - Combining ENISA and telecoms regulation
 - To run from 2011
 - And that ENISA continues till then
- ANC: keep remit wide, not just telcos/ISPs

Short-term future (2008-9)

- Network Resilience
 - From armoured fibres to IR exercises
 - And regulatory requirements
 - Workshop early March; call for interest on web
- Cooperation
 - Including CSIRT good practice/information exchange
- Emerging Risks
- Small/Medium Enterprises
 - Establishing needs/feasibility
