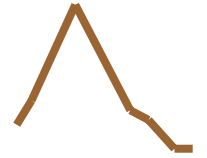

# TI mission

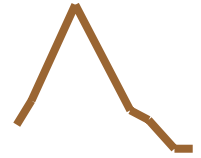


The Trusted Introducer must *foster trust and cooperation between CSIRTs in Europe*, both new and experienced, adopting the following tools:

- Registration
- Public services
- “Networking”
- Accreditation
- Value added services



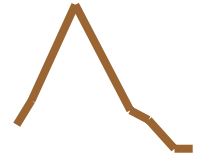
# TI tools (i)



- *Registration*: all “known” European CSIRTs are registered as TI Level 0
- *Public services*: all Level 0 team info is published “as is” on the TI website
- *“Networking”*: intensive use of adidas, pub, chat, dine, and other legacy protocols...



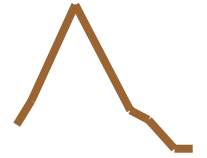
# TI tools (ii)



- *Accreditation*: CSIRTs that show to meet a set of basic requirements become TI Level 2 (this level is maintained!)
- *Value added services*: only available to Level 2 CSIRTs
  - Full CSIRT profiles offering extensive information
  - Downloadable keyblocks & CSV contact info
  - RIPE DB IRT object maintenance
  - Trusted mailing list <ti-level2@stelvio.nl>



# TI modus operandi

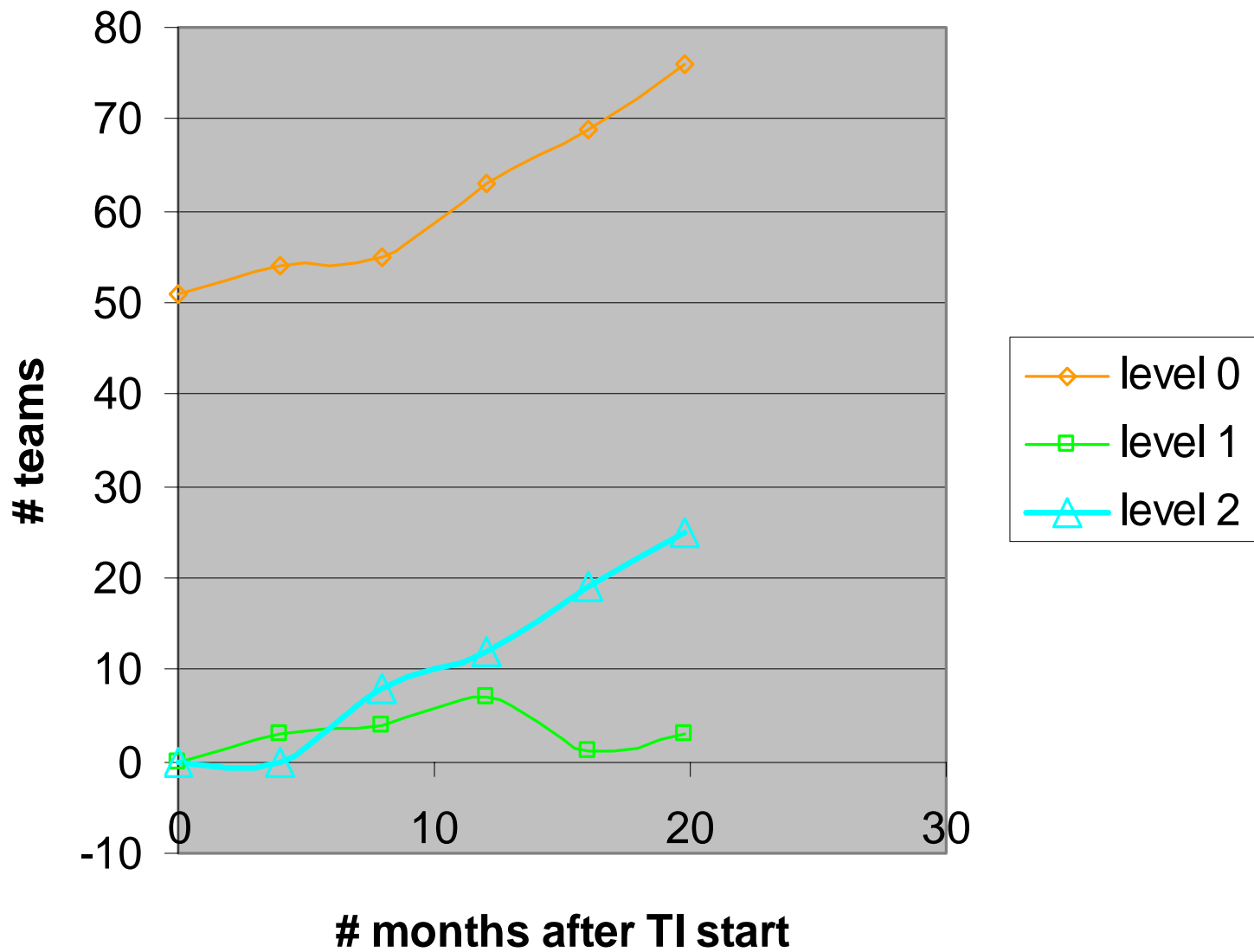


## TI is independent and non-commercial

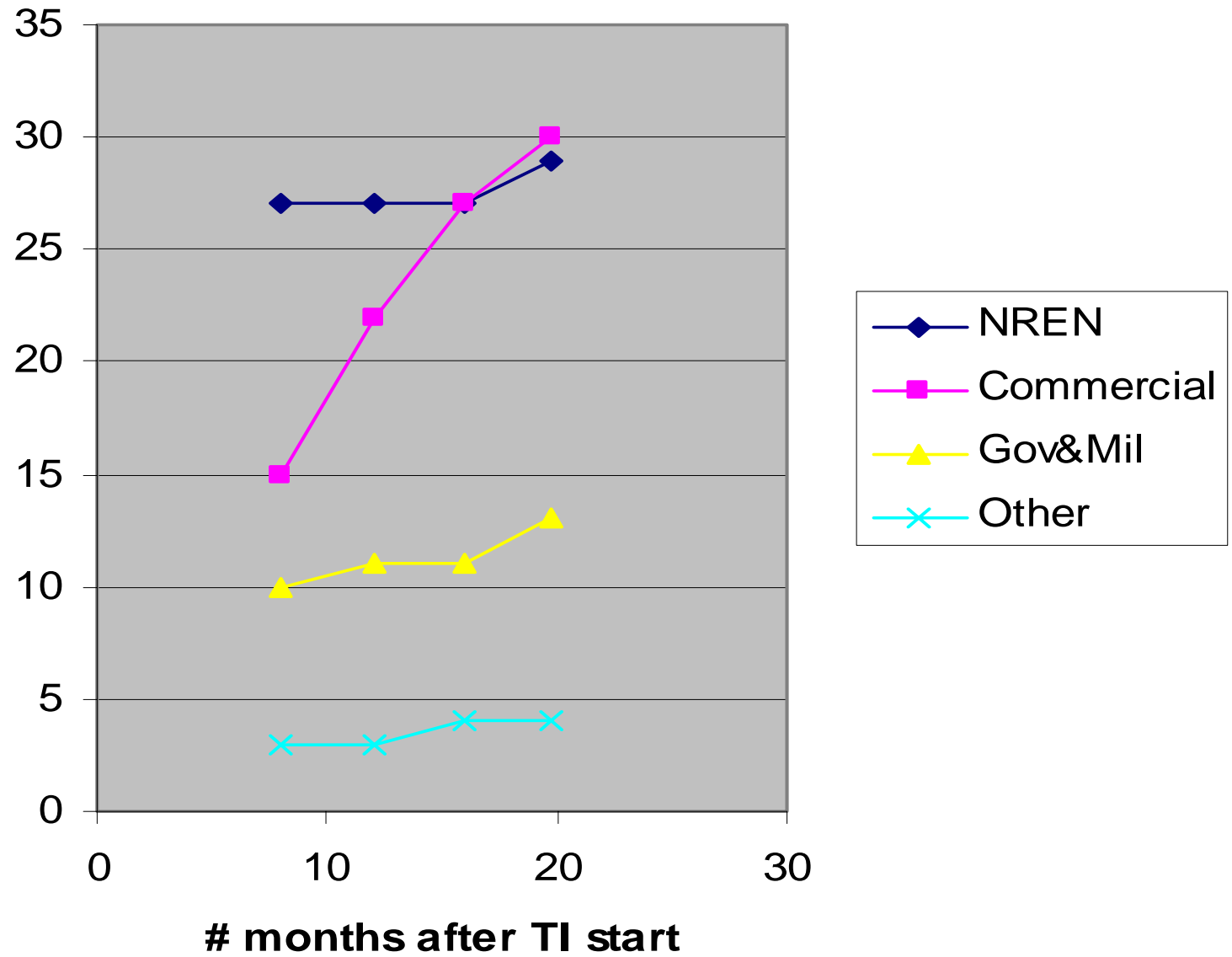


# # TI Registered Teams

## # Level 0 Teams

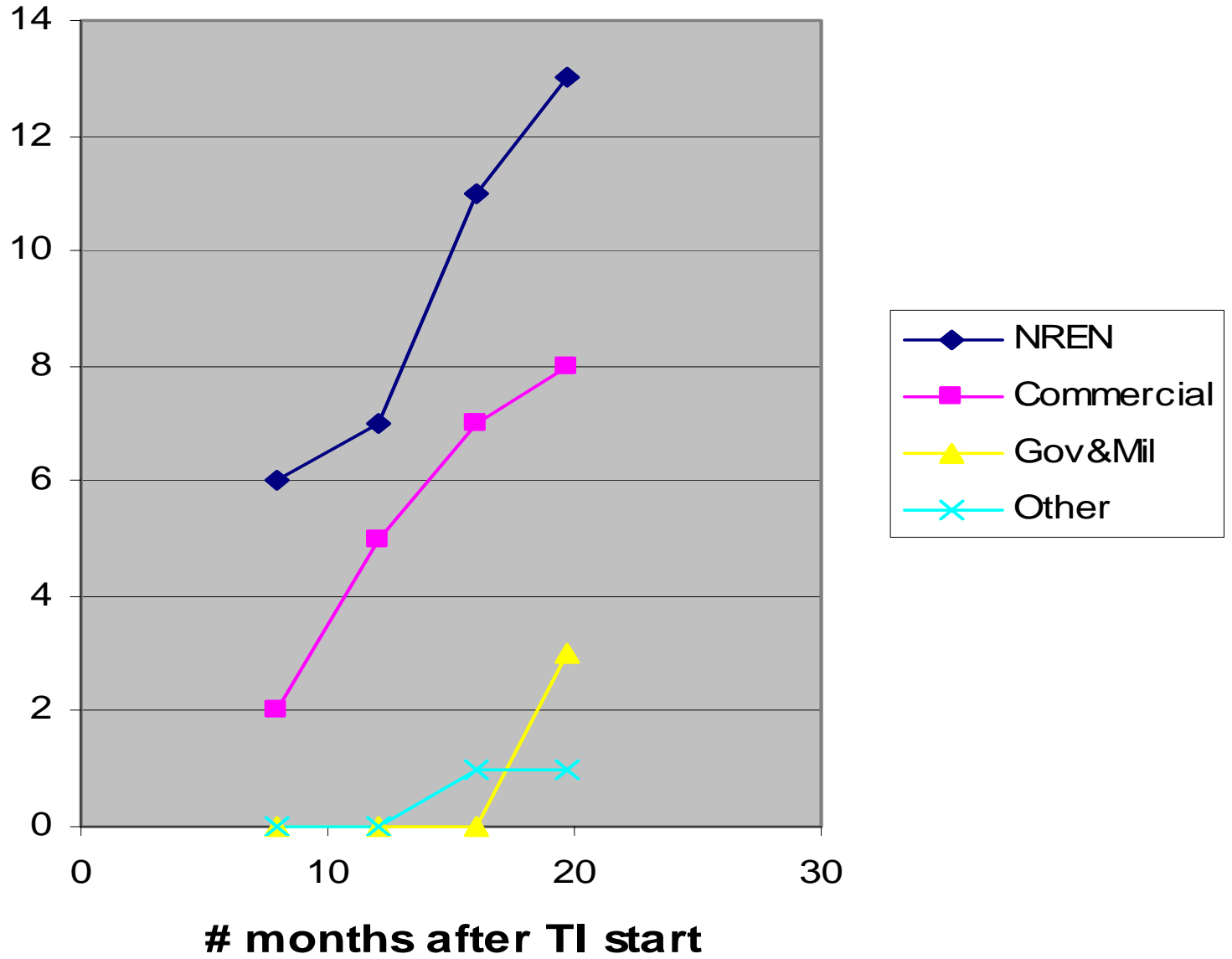

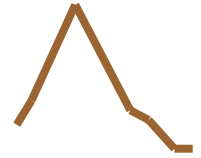
