- Aimed at gathering of incident reports by public and SMEs
- Portal where civilians and SMEs may report security incidents on a voluntary base
- Supply target group with statistical information w.r.t. the impact of IT-security incidents and tendencies within IT-security
- Use of web-based forms to allow structured report of incidents
