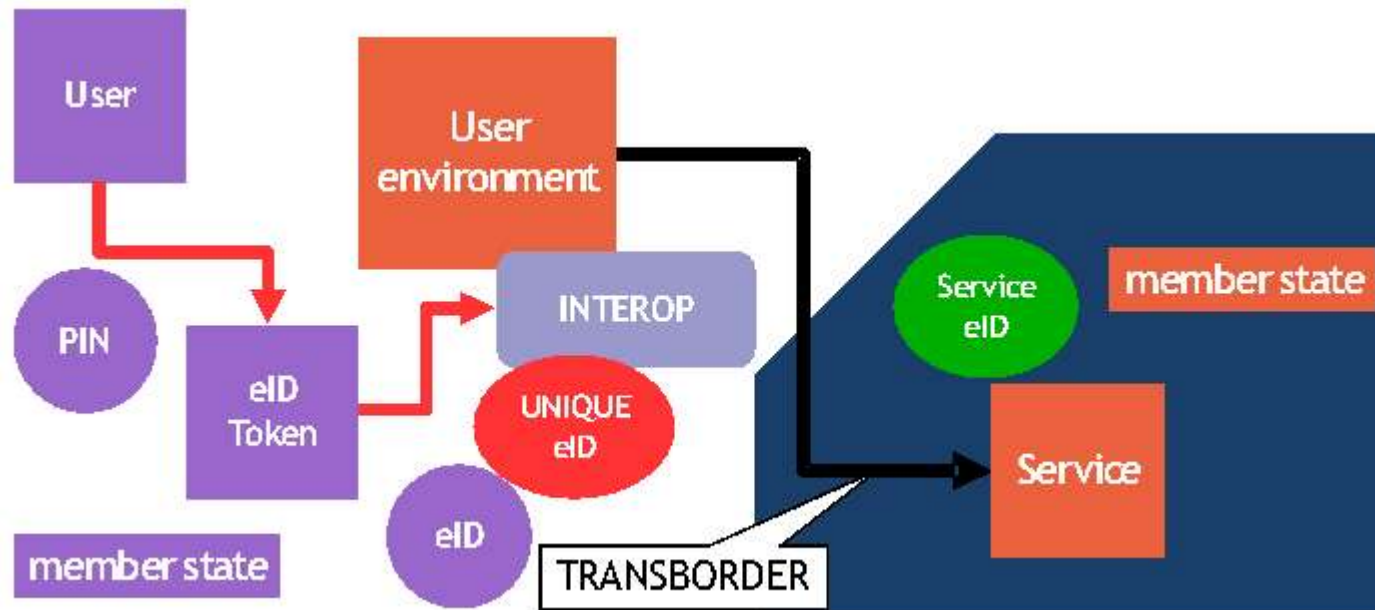

# EID large scale pilot

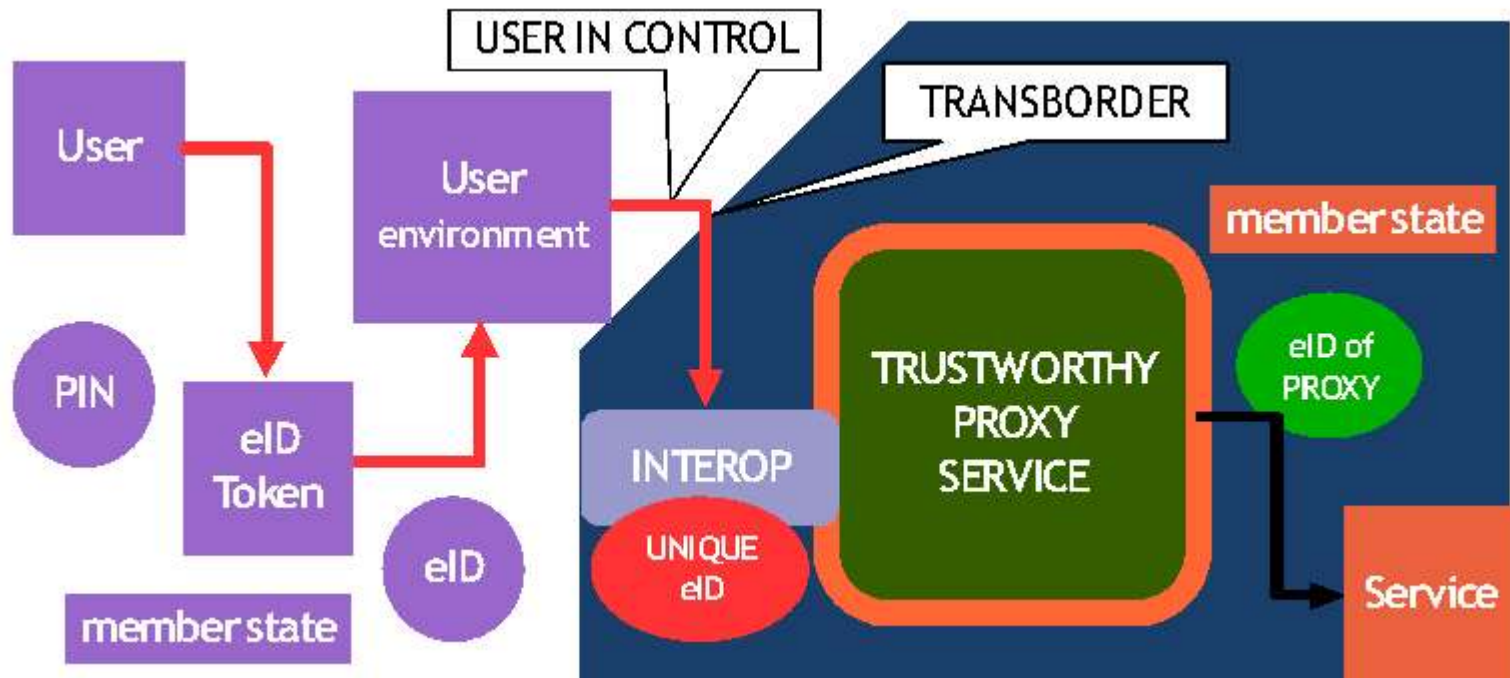
- The project has been split into 8 WPs (Work Packages) :

  - WP6 : eID access and portals
  - WP7/\* : eidentified applications
  - WP8 : communication and dissemination
