The third European Network Performing Arts Production workshop focus on the technology requirements for performing arts education, multi-site performance events, and high quality netcasting over advanced research networks. The workshop will include a mix of hands-on audio and video production techniques and presentations for those interested in the technical aspects of producing high quality network performing arts events.

- People from research and education community that produce performing arts events (academies or colleges of music, dance, arts etc.) that want to explore how to use advanced research networks services in teaching, rehearsals and performances
- People involved in audio / video production in other domains
- People from NRENs and other regional education networks whose constituencies may have a need to transmit high-end audiovisual productions.

Attendees will 'learn, touch and play' with diverse solutions, learn how audiovisual and network transmissions can support teaching, auditions and remote performances, see demonstrations of various tools and applications and enjoy live performances such as a masterclass with the New World Symphony and a performance by dancers in Brazil and Barcelona.
